Interviews for lifeguards, gate guards, and maintenance positions:

Gate guard and maintenance applicants must be 14 years or older.

Lifeguard applicants must be 16 years or older.

ALL APPLICANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DOWNLOAD THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS FROM THE BBC WEBSITE, COMPLETE THEM PRIOR TO THE INTERVIEW DATE, AND BRING THEM TO THE INTERVIEW. THOSE DOCUMENTS ARE: APPLICATION, I-9, W-4 and LS-55.

ALL APPLICANTS MUST BRING: A completed application, birth certificate or passport, photo ID such as school ID, Driver's license or Driver's permit.

APPLICANTS UNDER AGE 18 MUST ALSO BRING: Working papers. Working papers can be obtained from your school guidance office. If you turned 16 after August 2017, please renew your working papers.

LIFEGUARD APPLICANTS MUST ALSO BRING: all original certifications and copies.

Please note that if you will be turning 14 during the summer, you should come to the interview. You will be put on the schedule after your birthday as long as you have provided your working papers to management.

It is strongly suggested that all applicants attend one of the interviews and bring the appropriate documentation. Committee members will help employees complete all necessary paperwork and answer any questions they have at the time of the interviews.

Parents are welcome to wait while their child meets with committee members. **YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED INTO THE CLUBHOUSE.** You can wait in the foyer of the beach club as space permits.

If you are away at college or cannot attend either interview, you must have your application, I-9, W-4, copy of working papers, social security card, and any certifications to the Employment Committee by April 6. Please drop off these documents to Michelle Sangemino – 118 Beverly Road.
