BBC Marina Report

The warm weather is here! Now is the time to check that your boat is correctly tied up. CORRECT LINE SIZE in GOOD CONDITION should be used. We recommend for outside slips doubling up your lines especially on the port side.

Please remember to follow all rules when in the BBC Marina including:

- No swimming in the Marina.
- Children under the age of 13, without the supervision of an adult (18 or older), are prohibited at the Marina at all times.
- Dogs on leashes are permitted at the Marina; members are responsible for cleaning up after their animals.
- A list of all the Marina Rules can be found at: http://biltmorebeachclub.org/marina/marina-rules/

Kayaks, wakeboards, and all other dry-docked vessels must have an application and fees submitted BEFORE leaving them at the Marina. A "LATE FEE" will be added to ALL DRYDOCKED vessels that are not paid for. Applications are hanging in the bulletin board on the side of the Marina shack. Completed applications can be placed in the mail slot along with payment in the Marina shack door. Please use PERMANENT MARKER to put your LAST NAME in a visible spot on the outside rear of the vessel and make sure it is visible and easily seen. All unmarked Vessels will be subject to removal from the Marina!

No boats over 20' may use the Marina Ramp

Important Membership Reminders

In order to enjoy a healthy and safe summer at the Biltmore Beach Club, it would be greatly appreciated if everyone would be mindful of the Important Membership Reminders noted below:

- The lifeguards, maintenance crew and managers are not responsible for the supervision of children. Please supervise your children while at the Biltmore Beach Club ("Club") or Marina to make for a healthy and safe environment.
- All Members must check in with the Gate Guards at the Main Gate Entrance and sign in and/or follow any other procedure required by the Biltmore Beach Club Board of Directors, including waiting to check their pictures.
- When you enter the Club from the Marina with Guests, you must leave your name with the Marina Gate Guard and immediately proceed to the Main Gate to register and pay for Guests.
- Eligible Guests will be permitted entry to the facility when accompanied by a Member. Guests must provide proof of address, i.e., driver's license.
- All Members are responsible for their Guests' actions and must adhere to the Club's Rules and Regulations.
- All Members and their Guests are personally responsible and liable for any damages to the Club, including the Marina.
- Glass containers or bottles are prohibited in the Clubhouse, on the beach, in the bay, and the pool area.
- Food and/or Drinks are prohibited in the Pool area.
- Abusive or inappropriate language or physical actions will not be tolerated by Members or Guests.
- One Umbrella per family. Please return when done.
- The Ice Machine is reserved for Club functions; however, it may be available for Member use when not reserved; limit of one cooler per family, per day.
- Please be nice to our neighbors. Consider and respect their property and privacy. Please do not block our neighbor's driveway.



BBC Guest Policy

- Eligible Guests (those living outside the Boundaries detailed below) are permitted entry only when accompanied by a Member. Eligible Guests are those who reside outside the boundaries of the BBC. Those living within the following boundaries are *not* permitted into the BBC.
- The BBC boundaries are as follows:
 -The south side of Merrick Road
 -The east side of Ocean Avenue
 -The eastern boundary of Harbor Green (Bay Drive)
 -The southern boundary of Harbor Green (Dartmouth Road)
- Guests must provide proof of address (Driver's License or Photo ID).
- Members must accompany and stay with their Guests the entire time they are at the BBC.
- Members are responsible for the actions of their Guests and Guests must adhere to all of the BBC's Rules and Regulations.
- Guests should enter through the Main Gate. Members entering the BBC from the Marina with Guests must leave their names with the Gate Guard and go to the Main Gate to register and pay for Guests.
- Only Members may present Guest Passes.
- There shall be no more than 10 Guests per family on Holidays.
- There shall be no more than 10 adult Guests per family on Weekdays without prior approval of the Biltmore Beach Club Board of Directors.
- No corporate, company or business gatherings are permitted.



"TV Installation in Clubhouse" <u>Upcoming Motion</u>

At the last Membership Meeting (June 7th), a presentation was made by Clemente Mignone regarding the installation of a 75" TV on the east wall of the BBC Clubhouse. Following the presentation, a discussion was held regarding its usage, supervision, and cost. The TV would be enclosed and locked in a custom-made cabinet and would only be used during evening hours throughout the summer season.

If approved, the TV would be for adult usage and could be used for events such as: Membership and Board Meeting Presentations, important local and national events, schedules/agendas for upcoming events, sporting events, and for use by the Entertainment Committees for supervised special movie nights for kids and live photos/video steaming during adult parties, etc.

After careful consideration, the proposal would suggest that the TV only be available during summer evening hours (i.e., no earlier than 5:00 pm) with a more flexible viewing schedule throughout the winter season. During the winter season, children would not be allowed to be present in the Clubhouse (adults only,16 or older), and Clubhouse clean up would be required. Usage of the TV during any season would be on a reservation basis.

An outline for supervised usage and final details will be decided by the BBC Board. A motion will be presented to the membership at the July Membership Meeting. The membership vote will take place at the August Membership Meeting.
